- 8 residents requested signs
- 2 from 2015 did not request/didn't need
- Positive Responses
- Will require the signs be placed by 12 noon in 2017
- No other parking complaints

What did the NCD Board do in 2016?

- The Parking Management Plan was updated in December, 2016 with the years of experiences.
 - Parking Plan will be designed for each event with its specific considerations (weekend, weeknight, etc.) used to determine the plan
 - May include deposits to make sure the plan is undertaken as desired

What did the NCD Board do in 2016?

- May include a fee to have the CCC administer the plan (putting up the temporary signs)
- Goal is to discourage parking in the neighborhood

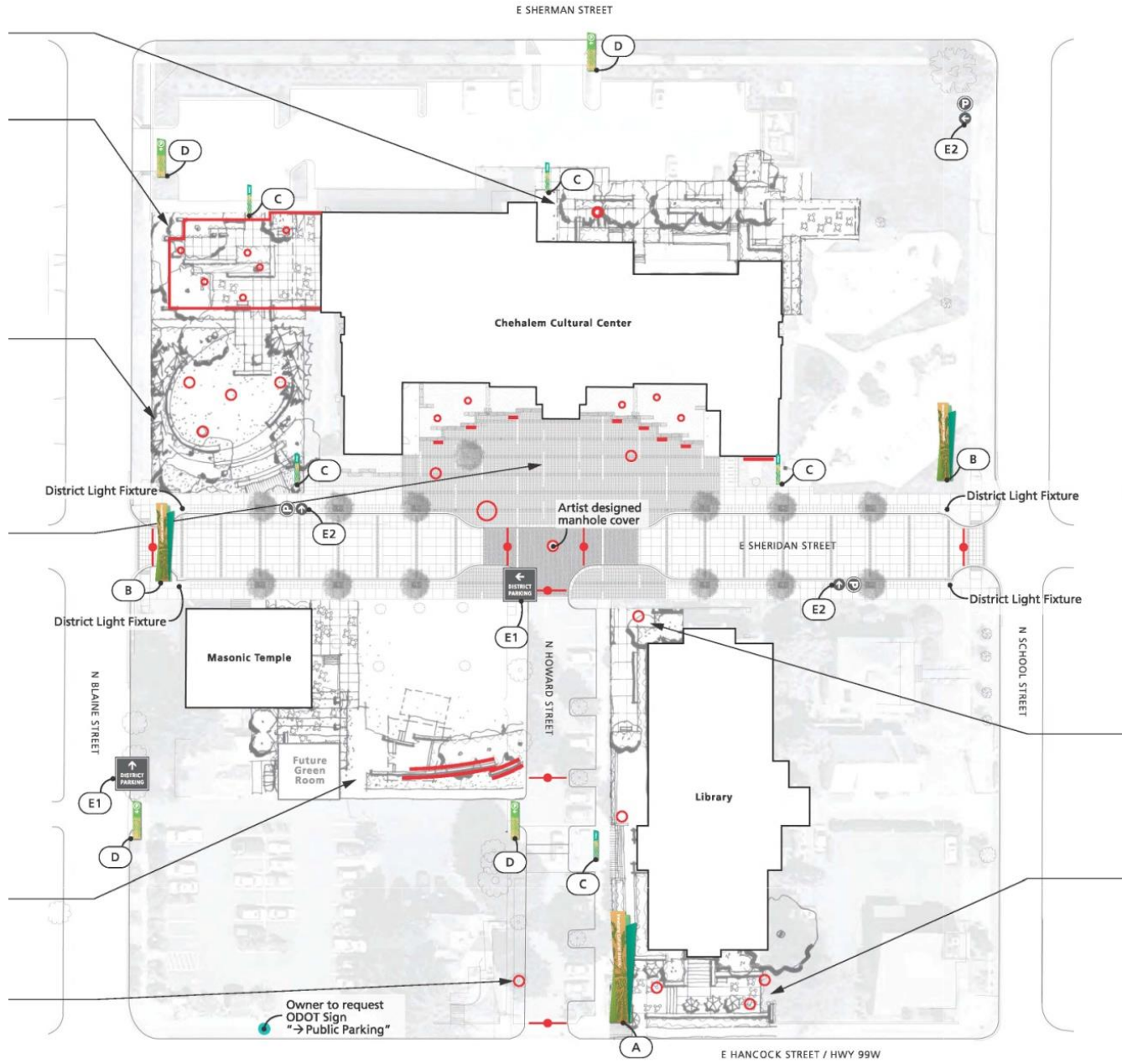
